

# DEFENCE FORCE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

## DETERMINATION NO. 1 OF 2011

### SALARIES – SENIOR OFFICER SPECIALIST – AMENDMENT

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*.

#### Commencement

1. This Determination commences on 17 March 2011.

#### Amendment

2. Determination No. 15 of 2008, Salaries, as amended, is amended as set out in this Determination.

#### Clause B.1.1 (Application)

3. Substitute:

“This Division applies to Senior Officers except:

- (a) the Chief, Capability Development Executive; and
- (b) the Chief of Joint Operations; and
- (c) any Medical Officer; and
- (d) any statutory or judicial office holder to whom salary is payable under a determination made by the Remuneration Tribunal.”.

#### Subclause B.3.1.2 (Application)

4. Omit the subclause

#### Subclause B.3.3.1 (Rate of salary for specialist officer), table

5. Substitute:

1.	a chaplain	specialist career structure on a fixed tenure or fixed period appointment	under Schedule B.5 according to the officer's Force, rank and competency level.

5.	a medical officer who did not accept a fixed tenure or fixed term appointment before 12 August 2003	non-specialist career structure	under Schedule B.8 Part 3 or 4, according to the officer's Force, rank and increment.
6.	a medical officer who was in service at 1 May 2004	specialist career structure because the member: (a) has not yet gained the required qualifications for a medical level; and (b) is in a position no higher than ML4; and (c) the CDF has deemed the member competent for a period ending no later than 1 May 2013	at the bottom increment of the deemed medical level under Schedule B.8 Part 1 or 2, according to the officer's Force and rank.
7.	an officer on a fixed tenure or fixed period appointment	specialist career structure and performing a year of compulsory medical residency	at the level "resident" under Schedule B.8 Part 1 or 2, according to the officer's Force.
8.	an aviation specialist	aviation specialist stream	under Schedule B.14 for the officer's Force and experience level.


9.	a medical officer who is a senior officer	specialist career structure	under Schedule B.15 Part 1 or 2, according to the officer's Force, rank and medical level.


