DETERMINATION NO. 11 OF 2007

PAY GRADE PLACEMENT FOR OFFICERS

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*:

Purpose

1. The purpose of the Determination is to permit timely implementation of officer pay grade placement while a replacement determination for Determination No. 6 of 1992, Salaries (as amended), is prepared, for consideration by 31 October 2007.

Commencement

2. This Determination commences on 9 August 2007.

Amendment


3.1 Determination No. 6 of 1992, Salaries, as amended, is amended as set out in Attachment A to this Determination.

3.2 To avoid doubt, Schedule 2C in Annex A to Attachment A to this Determination replaces Schedule 2C as amended by Determination No. 9 of 2007, Pay Grade Placement Warrant Officer Class 1.

3.3 Determination No. 22 of 2006, Remuneration Reform Project – Salary Rates for Other Ranks, as amended, is amended as set out in Attachment B to this Determination.



ATTACHMENT A

DETERMINATION NO. 6 OF 1992, SALARIES

Clause 10 (Annual increment of salary payable where member is competent)

1.1 Rename clause to:

“Salary point for a member”.

1.2 Substitute:

“10. A member is to be paid an annual increment of salary if:

- (a) the member is below the top increment for the member’s rank; and
- (b) the member ordinarily carries out duties and responsibilities at the standard for whichever is relevant of the member’s:
 - (i) rank; and
 - (ii) experience; and
 - (iii) pay grade or pay group; and
 - (iv) employment category (including any applicable classification).

Note: This clause does not a limit the capacity for another determination made under Part IIIA of the *Defence Act 1903* to provide for:

- (a) the placement of a member at a salary point, on enlistment, appointment, change in rank or change in pay grade or pay group; and
- (b) the deferral or refusal of an increment.”.

Clause 11 (Deferral of increment of salary)

2. Omit.

Clause 11A (Legal salary payable to certain legal officers not performing legal duties)

3. Renumber clause to clause 11.

Subclause 11A.2 (Legal salary payable to certain legal officers not performing legal duties) (renumbered by this Determination as clause 11.2)

4.1 Omit:

“subclause 11A.1”.

4.2 Insert:

“subclause 11.1”.

Clause 11A (Definitions)

5. Substitute:

“**11A.** In this Part:

“date of effect” for a relevant employment category, means the date of effect specified for that category in either of column 2 of Schedule 1A or column 2 of Schedule 2E;

“relevant employment category” means an employment category listed in either of column 1 of Schedule 1A or column 1 of Schedule 2E for the purposes of salary non-reduction.”.

Clause 11B (Application)

6. Substitute:

“**11B.** This Part applies to a member if, but for this Part, the salary payable to the member would be reduced as a result of:

(a) compulsory transfer from one employment category to another employment category;

(b) transfer of an employment category to a lower pay group or pay grade; or

(c) the restructure of an employment category,

but not if the reduction would result from:

(d) unsatisfactory performance of duty;

(e) disciplinary action; or

(f) administrative sanction.”.

Clause 11C (Entitlement to salary non-reduction)

7. Substitute:

“**11C.** During a salary non-reduction period of 18 months (or longer if so determined), a member is to continue to receive the rate of salary payable to the member immediately before this Part applies.”.

Subclause 11D.1 (Salary non-reduction period)

8. Substitute:

“**11D.1**For clause 11C, the salary non-reduction period begins on the day on which this Part applies to a member and ends:

(a) for a member with the rank of Warrant Officer Class 2 or lower who occupied a relevant employment category immediately before the date of effect – at the end of the day specified in column 3 of Schedule 1A;

- (b) for a member who is an officer who occupied a relevant employment category immediately before the date of effect – at the end of day specified in column 3 of Schedule 2E; and
- (c) for any other member – after 18 months.”.

Clause 11F (Salary non-reduction – member posted as Recruit Instructor (1 RTB))

9. Insert at the end:

“Retention of pay grade or pay group

11G.1 A member who ceases to be eligible for a pay grade or pay group may continue to be paid, at the rate applicable for the member’s rank and increment in that pay grade or pay group, if:

- (a) the member remains liable to serve in the employment category and (if relevant) the classification to which the pay grade or pay group related; and
- (b) the CDF approves the retention of a pay grade or pay group for:
 - (i) an other rank member or a Warrant Officer Class 1 for a period of up to three years where the member holds qualifications required for payment at that pay grade or pay group; or
 - (ii) an officer in accordance with any relevant instruction or direction made under sections 9 and 9A of the *Defence Act 1903*.”.

Clause 13A (Pay grade for an officer)

10. Substitute:

“13A.1 This clause applies to an officer who is not in one of the following classes:

- (a) An officer with the rank of Brigadier or higher.
- (b) A specialist officer, including any of the following:
 - (i) A chaplain.
 - (ii) A dental officer.
 - (iii) A legal officer.
 - (iv) A medical officer

13A.2 An officer holds the pay grade that is:

- (a) specified in Schedule 2C for the Service, employment category and classification (if any) that the officer holds; or
- (b) if Schedule 2C does not specify a pay grade that applies to the member — pay grade 2.

13A.3 If more than one pay grade applies to an officer under Schedule 2C, the higher pay grade is taken to apply to the officer.

13A.4 A pay grade listed in Schedule 2C applies to an officer for the period that the officer meets the requirements for the relevant employment category and classification (if any), including if relevant, required levels of qualification and skill.

13A.5 The pay grade for an officer of the Royal Australian Air Force, who does not hold an aircrew employment category, is increased by one if the member:

- (a) holds a pay grade below pay grade 10; and
- (b) is appointed to, and exercises, a command position.”.

Subclause 19.1 (Rate of salary – trainee)

11. Insert at end:

“**19.2** This clause does not apply to a member classified as "under training" in Schedule 2C.”.

Clause 22A (Pay grade for an officer of the Reserve Forces)

12. Substitute:

“**22A.1** This clause applies to an officer of the Reserve Forces who is not in one of the following classes:

- (a) An officer with the rank of Brigadier or higher.
- (b) A specialist officer, including any of the following:
 - (i) A chaplain.
 - (ii) A dental officer.
 - (iii) A legal officer.
 - (iv) A medical officer.

22A.2 An officer of the Reserve Forces holds the pay grade that is:

- (a) specified in Schedule 2C for the Service, employment category and classification (if any) that the officer holds; or
- (b) if Schedule 2C does not specify a pay grade that applies to the officer — pay grade 2; or
- (c) if clause 21 provides that salary is payable to the officer at a discounted rate — pay grade 2 at the discounted rate.

22A.3 If more than one pay grade applies to an officer under Schedule 2C, the higher of the pay grades is taken to apply to the officer.

22A.4 A pay grade listed in Schedule 2C applies to an officer for the period that the officer meets the requirements for the relevant employment category and classification (if any), including if relevant, required levels of qualification and skills.

22A.5 The pay grade for an officer of the Air Force Reserve, who does not hold an aircrew employment category, is increased by one if the member:

- (a) holds a pay grade below pay grade 10; and
- (b) is appointed to, and exercises, a command position.”.

Column 3 of Schedule 1A (Salary non-reduction – relevant employment categories, dates of effect and dates of cessation)

13.1 Under Navy – Pay Group 5, omit twice occurring:

“22 May 2007”.

13.2 Insert twice occurring:

“22 May 2009”.

Schedule 2C (Pay grades for officers)

14. Substitute with the Schedule in Annex A to this Determination.

Schedule 2D (Pay grades for Warrant Officer Class 1)

15. Insert at the end:

Schedule 2E – Salary non-reduction - Officers

Notes:

1. In this Schedule, "Employment Category" includes a mustering, professional qualification or specialisation.
2. In this Schedule, categories that require a member to hold specific experience, qualification or skill may include one or a combination of the following descriptions in the employment category or classification title:

Item	This descriptor...	means...
1.	Command	Command exercised by a member who is or has been, exercising the duties of command in a command position identified by the Chief of the member's Service.
2.	Fly 0-2	A member with flying experience of less than 2 years.
3.	Fly 2-4	A member with flying experience of 2 years up to 4 years.
4.	Fly 4-6	A member with flying experience of 4 years up to 6 years.
5.	Fly 6-8	A member with flying experience of 6 years up to 8 years.
6.	Fly 8-10	A member with flying experience of 8 years up to 10 years.
7.	Fly 10+	A member with flying experience of 10 or more years.
8.	SM	A qualified submariner other than (a) A member who has the rank of Rear Admiral in the Navy, or a higher rank. (b) A member who is a Medical or Dental Officer with the rank of Commander in the Navy, or a higher rank.
