[1] This statement should be read in conjunction with our earlier decision¹ in relation to this matter published in May 2019. That decision resulted in a new salary structure provided to remunerate Navy and Army rotary wing aviation officers under DFRT Determination 3 of 2019 with effect from 01 July 2019.

[2] Since that time the ADF states it has been "finalising the mapping of the affected aviation members in Navy and Army" and has now become aware of "a small group of rotary aviation officers who did not quite fit the provisions set out in the submission".² We met with the ADF on 15 August 2019 to discuss these implications and subsequently agreed to modify some transition time periods, gateways and transition triggers to accommodate those circumstances. We accept that were we to apply the previously agreed provisions to those officers they may suffer financial disadvantage.

Statement - Matter 6 of 2018 - ADF Rotary Wing Aviation Officers

[3] While we make every effort to avoid retrospective commencement dates, subsection 58H(8) of the *Defence Act 1903* makes provision as long as the criteria of that subsection are met; we are satisfied this determination meets those criteria. Accordingly, Determination 3 of 2019 takes effect from 01 July 2019.
