[1] This statement should be read in conjunction with our decision in Matter 3 of 2018 – Australian Army Band Corps – Restructure.<sup>1</sup> In that decision we agreed to salary non-reduction provisions (NRP) being determined for a period of five years, and required the ADF to report back to us '*at the conclusion of that period to advise on the outcomes of those provisions*'.

[2] This report back meets that requirement and provides a review on the progress of the provisions. We considered this report back in a hearing on 22 February 2024.

[3] We note that the Army Band Corps is a '*relatively small*' workforce of 158 personnel. We accept that, at the conclusion of the five-year period, one member remains on NRP because of their pattern of Reserve service, which has prevented them meeting the requirements within the timeframe. The ADF advise it intends to provide a single 12-month extension to this member under s.58B of the Defence Act 1903.<sup>2</sup>
